February Monthly Financial Report and Cash Flow Report by Walter Wallace

- Mr. Wallace gave an overview of current financial status stating net income of close to \$49.972.65.
- Once the state certify enrollment, we are paid off over payment with state and will receive \$60K from the state from Spring enrollment.
- By end June budget projection shows deficit of cash \$63,885 that state apporptionment will be sent to AMA.

CEO Update by Dana Hammond

- Virtual internship has been connecting with industry professionals. Plans are underway to turn these experiences into paid internships.
- Artist and guest artist available as activity for after school to help support struggling scholars.
- There is a Cal OSHA guidelines to help students stay safe.
- Dana is hosting 3 townhall meetings to help inform the community about these plans in order to serve scholars who are struggling or have a learning difference.
- The reopening plan will include help support the families through hybrid learning model that will separate students into two separate cohorts to ensure safe reopening.
- Projected number for next year is 90 students and we already have 80 students already enrolled.
